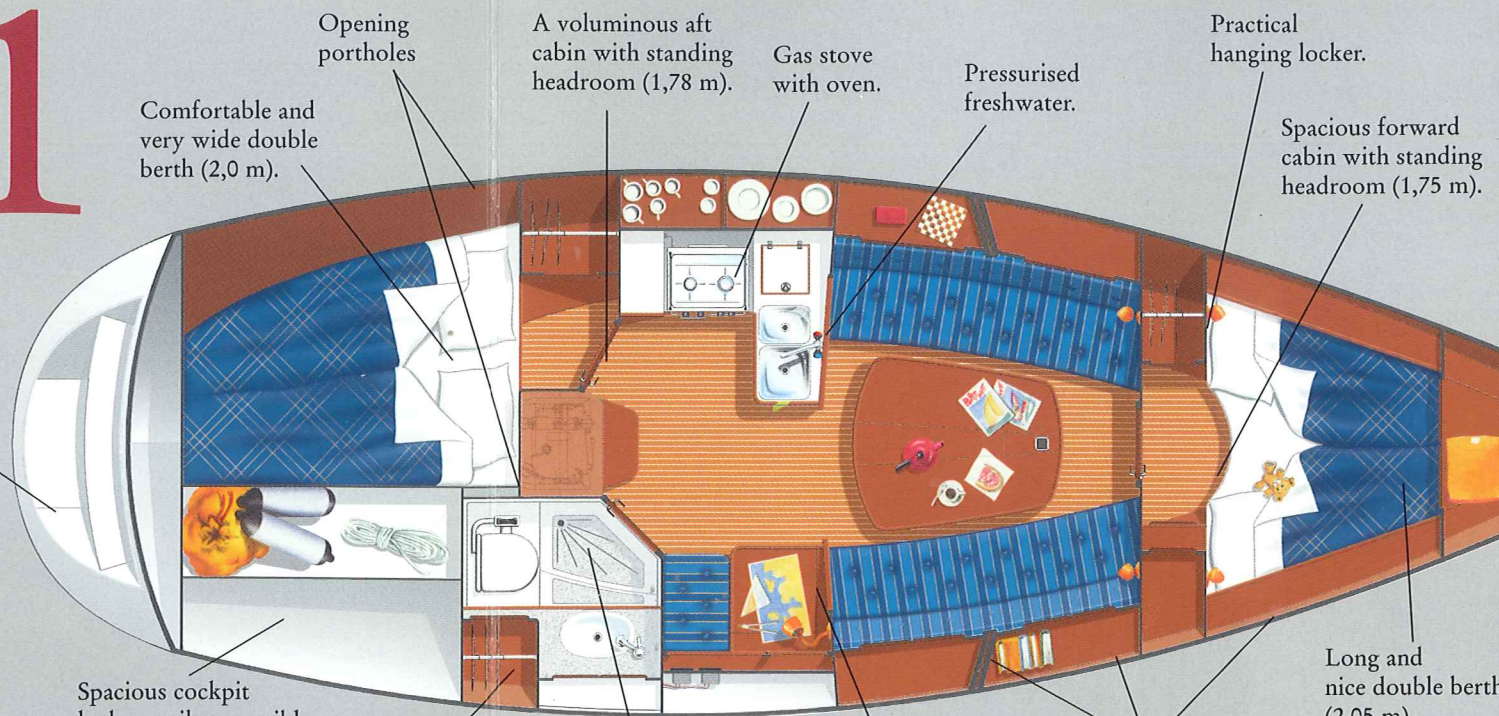


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**NAJAD**



# Najad 331



Very good ventilation and well insulated hull results in a dry and comfortable living environment.

Comfortable and very wide double berth (2,0 m).

Opening portholes

A voluminous aft cabin with standing headroom (1,78 m).

Gas stove with oven.

Pressurised freshwater.

Practical hanging locker.

Spacious forward cabin with standing headroom (1,75 m).

Stiff and strong hull due to the sandwich construction and multi-axial roving laminate using ISO polyester resin and NGA gelcoat to give a water tight surface.

Fixed windscreen in toughened glass with sprayhood.

A fractional rig 19/20 with the spreaders angled backwards may be trimmed like a 7/8-mast, but have the stability of a masthead rig.

Spacious cockpit locker easily accessible under starboard seat.

Ventilated wet locker.

Large heads compartment with shower.

Functional navigation area facing forward.

Plenty of cupboards and shelves all around the yacht.

Long and nice double berth (2,05 m).

Integral swimming platform with ladder.

The yacht may be sailed using the Genoa only due to a large fore triangel. This also suits a self tacking jib.

Long sailing waterline for very good windward performance.

Wide and flat hull line at the stern results in high buoyancy and excellent down wind performance.

Volvo Penta 20.2 kW (28 hp) with folding propeller.

A fully balanced spade rudder with a strong rudder post (65 mm) on double roller bearings inclined aft. This guarantees easy and precise steering with directional stability.

A sharp bow cuts the waves easily resulting in low water resistance.

A long fin keel of NACA wing sections with a widened base gives directional stability and reduces drag.

In the new Najad 331 we have created a yacht with excellent sailing performance without compromising any of the traditional Najad qualities.

The Najad 331 is the result of an exciting combination of modern computerised CAD/CAM technology with craftsmanship developed from generations of quality boat building.

The Najad 331 is not only impressive to sail, it has a well designed layout, featuring two large cabins, in the bow and aft, enabling four people to live comfortably on board. The outstanding precision and high quality of finish is typical of the Najad yard which has 25 years of knowledge and experience.

There is no doubt that the new Najad 331 will be welcomed by any cruising sailor who has aspired to own a quality, ocean-going Najad.

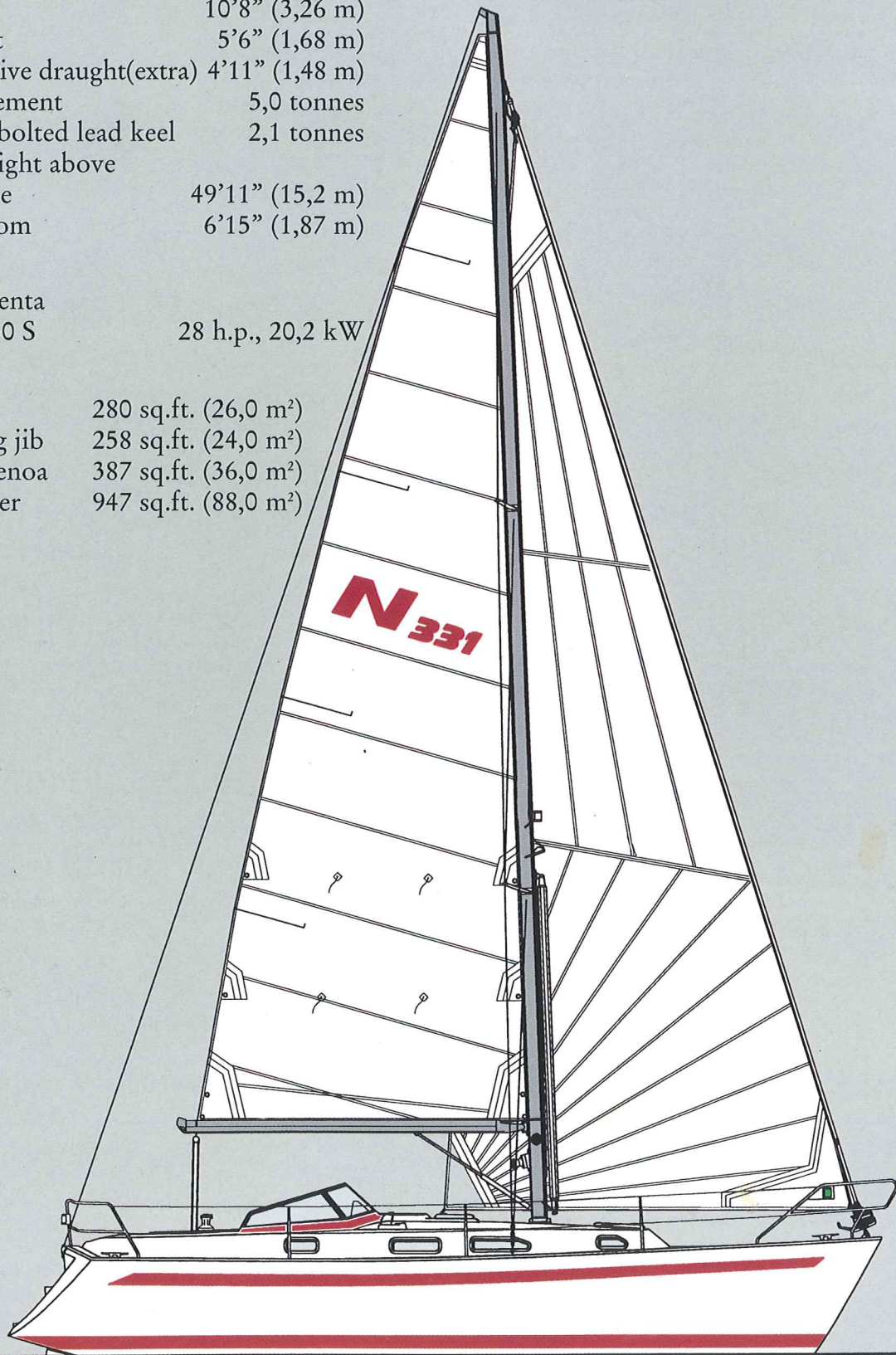
